January 25, 2026 – 1807 hours

Officers were dispatched to assist the medics with an unresponsive subject on Marcia Drive. They were pronounced deceased on arrival. Foul play is not suspected.

January 26, 2026 – 1611 hours

Officers were dispatched to a road obstruction on W. Franklin Street. On arrival, they found a snowblower in the roadway. The object was safely removed.

Officers were dispatched to a dispute on E. Franklin Street. Upon arrival, the parties were separated. Further investigation revealed that the dispute was verbal only and no threats or violence occurred. Officers stood by while one party left the area. No further complaints were received.
