February 8, 2026 – 0840 hours

February 8, 2026 – 2103 hours

Officers initiated a traffic stop for a speed violation on W. Franklin Street. After further investigation, officers determined that the subject was operating a vehicle while intoxicated. Officers also located several alcoholic beverages in the vehicle. The driver was taken into custody and charged with OVI, open container and speed. They were released to a responsible party.

The subject was transported to the hospital for further evaluation and charged with Disorderly Conduct and OOB.
