March 15, 2026 – 1316 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on W. Franklin Street. Entry gained.

March 16, 2026 – 0341 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 for an alarm drop. Confirmed FA.

March 16, 2026 – 0743 hours

Officers were dispatched to an alarm at a residence on North Field Drive. Confirmed FA.

March 16, 2026 – 1821 hours

Officers were dispatched to assist the medics on E. Maple Street.

March 17, 2026 – 0359 hours

Officers responded to Clear View Court on a noise complaint involving a barking dog. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

March 17, 2026 – 2019 hours

Officers responded to Ridgetop Drive to speak with a resident regarding a welfare check request for a friend. After speaking with the resident, it was determined that the friend possibly lived somewhere in Dayton or Cincinnati. Officers were not able to determine where the subject lived.

March 18, 2026 – 1615 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Streamview Court. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

March 18, 2026 – 2200 hours

While on patrol, officers stopped to check the welfare of a subject on E. Franklin Street. They checked OK.



March 19, 2026 – 1328 hours

A suspicious person was reported on Sugarcreek Drive. Officers located the subject and confirmed there was no cause for complaint.

March 19, 2026 –1751 hours

Officers responded to Shore Drive to follow up on a littering complaint that occurred on N. West Street. One subject was issued a written warning for littering.

March 19, 2026 – 1855 hours

Officers responded to a neighbor dispute involving trash cans on Polo Trace Court.

March 19, 2026 – 1925 hours

Officers responded to a traffic complaint on Hess Road involving a subject riding a 4-wheeler in the roadway. Officers located the subject and advised they cannot ride the 4-wheeler on a public roadway. No further complaints were received.

March 20, 2026 – 0813 hours

Officers were dispatched to assist the medics on S. Linda Drive.

March 20, 2026 – 1001 hours

Officers responded to Post to meet with a subject regarding a possible assault that occurred on E. Franklin Street. The investigation is ongoing.

March 21, 2026 – 1104 hours

Officers were dispatched to the area of N. Belleview Drive after a resident reported hearing gunshots. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate. It was later determined that the sounds were likely from firearms training occurring in the Township.



March 21, 2026 – 1856 hours

A welfare check was requested on Little Sugarcreek Road. All subjects checked OK.

March 21, 2026 – 2158 hours

A welfare check was requested on Tampico Trail. All residents checked OK.

March 21, 2026 – 2212 hours

Officers were dispatched to check on suspicious people on Shore Drive. After further investigation, officers determined the RP's neighbor was hosting a party. Officers spoke with those attending the party and determined there was no cause for complaint at this time. No further calls were received.

March 21, 2026 – 2215 hours

Officers initiated a traffic stop on State Route 725 after witnessing the passenger throwing trash from the vehicle. The passenger was subsequently issued a citation for littering.
