March 29, 2026 – 0851 hours

Officers were dispatched to assist the medics on Ridgeway Rd.

March 29, 2026 – 1433 hours

Officers were dispatched to a noise complaint on Regent Park Drive involving juveniles riding dirtbikes on private property. The juveniles had permission and were supervised. Officers spoke to the parents and juveniles regarding the noise level. No further complaints were received.

March 30, 2026 – 1550 hours

A welfare check was requested on a juvenile who appeared lost on State Route 725. The juvenile checked OK and was returned home.

March 30, 2026 – 1610 hours

A welfare check was requested on Moss Oak Trail. All residents checked OK.

March 30, 2026 – 1848 hours

Officers were dispatched to a juvenile complaint on Regent Park Drive involving juveniles riding e-bikes. Officers did not observe any violations or concerns.

April 1, 2026 – 1647 hours

Officers met with a resident on Post regarding a tenant/landlord dispute on E. Franklin Street. Officers advised the complainant that the issue was Civil and referred them to the Court.

April 2, 2026 – 0446 hours

Officers were dispatched to Lakeman Drive on a suspicious persons complaint. The caller stated he observed a vehicle occupied with several males attempting to open car doors. When the occupants saw the caller, the vehicle left at a high rate of speed. Officers searched the area but were unable to locate. While patrolling the area, officers located one vehicle with an open door on Moss Oak Trail that appeared to be rummaged through.



April 2, 2026 – 1125 hours

Officers were dispatched to Plantation Trail on an attempted vehicle break-in. The complainant observed several males on their cameras attempting to open their car doors. The vehicles were locked and no damage was reported.

April 2, 2026 – 1517 hours

Officers spoke with a resident on Bradley Court regarding a theft complaint. Sometime overnight, the victim had items stolen from their vehicle. It is believed that this incident is related to the others reported on April 2. The investigation is ongoing.

April 2, 2026 – 1556 hours

Officers responded to a domestic dispute on W. Franklin Street. The investigation is ongoing.

April 3, 2026 – 0841 hours

Officers assisted with a disabled vehicle on S. Linda Drive.

April 3, 2026 – 0954 hours

Officers were dispatched to an alarm on Hillrise Circle. Confirmed FA.

April 3, 2026 – 2243 hours

Officers were dispatched to Knoll Drive on a domestic dispute. After speaking with all parties involved, it was determined that the dispute was physical. Officers took one subject into custody and transported them to the Greene County Jail without incident.

April 4, 2026 – 0457 hours

A suspicious vehicle was reported in a grassy area off of the roadway on W. Franklin Street. When officers arrived, the vehicle was running and the headlights were on, and officers observed a male asleep in the drivers seat. After further investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for OVI – Physical Control of a Motor Vehicle. The driver was cited and released to a responsible party.



April 4, 2026 – 0502 hours

Officers were dispatched to E. Franklin Street on the report of juveniles loitering in the area. Officers located the juveniles, spoke with their parents and returned them home.

April 4, 2026 – 0950 hours

Officers responded to Barnett Drive on a residential alarm. Confirmed FA.

April 4, 2026 – 1905 hours

Officers assisted with a vehicle lockout on Lakeman Drive. Entry gained.

April 4, 2026 – 2036 hours

Officers responded to a harassment complaint on Woodedge Drive. After speaking with the complainant, it was determined no criminal act occurred. Documentation report only.
