**April 26, 2026 – 1259 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a property damage crash on Ridgeway Rd. Information exchange only.

**April 26, 2026 – 1351 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Upper Hillside Drive on a soliciting complaint. Officers located the subject and advised them how to obtain a soliciting permit. They left the area without incident.

**April 26, 2026 – 1659 hours**

Officers spoke with a resident on Ryder Court regarding a harassment complaint. Information only at this time.

**April 26, 2026 – 1744 hours**

Officers assisted with traffic control on S. Main Street after a truck damaged utility wires.

**April 27, 2026 – 0121 hours**

A suspicious vehicle was reported on Rosecrest Drive. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

**April 27, 2026 – 0502 hours**

A welfare check was requested on S. Main Street. The subject checked OK but reported that they had lost their vehicle keys.

A Peace Officer standby was requested at Post. Officers stood by for a property exchange without incident.



**April 27, 2026 – 1429 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Mill Run Lane on a disturbance. One subject reported being pushed and slapped. No injuries were reported and the complainant declined to press charges. Officers stood by as the subject left the area.

**April 27, 2026 – 1656 hours**

Officers were dispatched to check the welfare of a subject in a parked vehicle on S. Main Street. The subject checked OK and notified officers that they still were unable to locate the key to the vehicle.

**April 27, 2026 – 1752 hours**

Officers spoke with a resident on Wead Place regarding a telecommunications harassment complaint.

**April 27, 2026 – 2135 hours**

Officers were dispatched to assist the Fire Department on Lakeview Drive.

**April 28, 2026 – 2029 hours**

Officers were dispatched to N. Linda Drive on a trespassing complaint.

**April 28, 2026 – 2229 hours**

Officers were dispatched to W. Franklin Street around Bellbrook Plaza on the report of a group of suspicious juveniles swinging golf clubs. The subjects were GOA and officers did not locate any signs of damage or criminal activity.

**April 29, 2026 – 0956 hours**

Officers were dispatched to Wentworth Village for a found property report.



**April 29, 2026 – 1951 hours**

Officers responded to E. Franklin Street on the report of an intoxicated subject. Officers stood by while the subject waited for a ride.

**April 30, 2026 – 1658 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a trespassing complaint on N. Linda Drive. The complainant had video of the same juveniles continually trespassing on their property. Officers located the juveniles and spoke with parents to advise of the complaint.

**May 1, 2026 – 0717 hours**

Officers responded to a littering complaint on Plantation Trail. Officers were able to locate the suspect and issued a written warning for littering. No further complaints were received.

**May 1, 2026 – 1202 hours**

Officers were dispatched to a soliciting complaint on Big Tree Rd. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

**May 1, 2026 – 1609 hours**

Officers responded to Post to meet with a subject regarding questions about retrieving property from a residence. Officers advised that the matter was Civil and referred them to their Attorney or the Court for further assistance.

**May 1, 2026 – 1706 hours**

A suspicious person was reported in Bellbrook Plaza. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

**May 1, 2026 – 2247 hours**

Officers responded to Creekview Place after a neighbor requested a welfare check due to loud noises and people screaming. Officers confirmed that the noises were coming from a juveniles birthday party. No cause for complaint.



### **May 2, 2026 – 0222 hours**

While on patrol, officers located a suspicious vehicle on W. Franklin Street. Officers spoke with the occupant and determined there was no cause for complaint, subject was permitted to be there.

### **May 2, 2026 – 1017 hours**

Officers responded to Pinegrove Drive on an attempted theft complaint. Unknown subjects opened the complainants car door overnight and rummaged through the vehicle. Officers spoke with several neighbors in the area that had video footage of juveniles in a silver sedan running down the street attempting to open car doors. No items were reported stolen or damaged, information only at this time. Unable to identify the suspects.

### **May 2, 2026 – 1950 hours**

Officers responded to Sable Ridge Drive on the report of a suspicious vehicle that had been sitting in front of multiple different houses over the course of several hours. Officers located the subject, who stated he was a solicitor. The vehicle had a strong odor of marijuana, and the subject was later issued a citation for underage possession of marijuana. They were warned for soliciting without a permit and left the area without incident. No further complaints were received.
