May 3, 2026 – 0413 hours

Officers were dispatched to assist the fire department with a house fire on Brookwood Drive. Upon arrival, it was confirmed that one resident was still inside. First Responders attempted entry but were unable to due to heavy smoke and fire. One fatality was confirmed and three people were treated for smoke and fire related injuries.

May 3, 2026 – 0941 hours

A Peace Officer standby was requested on Polo Trace Ct. Officers stood by for a property exchange.

May 3, 2026 – 1743 hours

Officers spoke with a resident on Lower Hillside Dr. regarding a noise complaint.

May 4, 2026 – 0839 hours

Officers spoke with a resident on Polo Trace Ct. regarding a potential protection order violation. After further information and investigation, it was determined that no violation occurred.

May 4, 2026 – 0938 hours

Officers spoke with a resident on Post regarding a Civil issue.

May 4, 2026 –1143 hours

Officers spoke with a victim on Post regarding the theft of an iPad from their vehicle. The complainant believed it occurred when his vehicle was parked on W. Franklin Street. The iPad was able to be located in Spring Valley Township. No suspects at this time.

April 4, 2026 – 1615 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on W. Frankin Street for a disturbance. At the request of the manager, the subject was trespassed from the business.



May 4, 2026 – 1756 hours

Officers were dispatched to Mill Run Lane on a disturbance. One subject reported being pushed and slapped. No injuries were reported and the complainant declined to press charges. Officers stood by as the subject left the area.

Officers were dispatched to assist Animal Control with a dog bite complaint on Woodedge Dr.

Officers were dispatched to a parking complaint on Garry Drive.

Officers were dispatched to Upper Bellbrook Road on a noise complaint. Officers determined the noise was from utility workers repairing a transformer in an effort to restore power. No cause for complaint.

A suspicious person was reported on S. Lakeman Drive. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

May 6, 2026 – 1042 hours

Officers were dispatched to investigate an open door on Regent Park Drive. Officers cleared the house and saw no signs of forced entry or criminal activity.



May 6, 2026 – 1214 hours

Officers spoke with a resident of Polo Trace Court regarding a protection order violation. Further investigation revealed that a violation did occur. The suspect was later arrested in Centerville and transported to the Greene County Jail without incident.

Officers were dispatched to a complaint involving juveniles trespassing on private property on S. West Street. Officers located the group of juveniles and they left the property. No further complaints were received.

May 7, 2026 – 1233 hours

Officers responded to crash on Washington Mill Road involving a utility trailer that had disconnected and overturned. No injuries were reported and the driver was cited.
