June 7, 2026 – 0233 hours

Officers were dispatched to Ryder Court to attempt to locate a subject for the Greene County Sheriff's Office. Unable to locate.

June 7, 2026 – 1306 hours

Officers responded to Moss Oak Trail on the report of a domestic dispute, past occurred. Officers determined the dispute was physical, and the suspect was no longer at the scene. Officers were able to locate the suspect, and they were transported to the Greene County Jail without incident.

June 7, 2026 – 1904 hours

Officers were dispatched to a juvenile complaint on N. Belleview Drive. The caller stated a young juvenile was riding a scooter in the street. Officers checked the area but were unable to locate.

June 8, 2026 – 0852 hours

Officers responded to a damaging complaint on N. Belleview Drive. The complainant advised an exterior window sustained damage consistent with a BB. Officers were not able to locate a BB and there are no suspects at this time.

Upon arrival, officers determined that a trash truck drove underneath wires that became caught on the top of the truck. The impact with the wires caused a pole to snap and wires to break. No injuries were reported.
