June 28, 2026 – 0322 hours

Officers responded to a noise complaint on Spring Creek Circle.

June 28, 2026 – 0612 hours

Officers were dispatched to a noise complaint on Knob Hill. Unfounded.

June 28, 2026 – 1035 hours

Officers were dispatched to a private property crash on W. Franklin Street. Officers stood by while the parties exchanged information.

June 28, 2026 – 1753 hours

Officers assisted a motorist with a disabled vehicle on W. Franklin Street.

June 29, 2026 – 2226 hours

Officers responded to a private property crash at a business on E. Franklin Street. Officers stood by while the parties exchanged information.

June 30, 2026 – 1322 hours

Officers were dispatched to Regent Park Drive on a barking dog complaint.



June 30, 2026 – 1655 hours

Officers were dispatched to State Route 725 on a hit/skip crash. No injuries were reported, but the vehicle had minor damage. The at-fault unit left the scene.

A welfare check was requested on E. Franklin Street. One subject was transported to the hospital for further evaluation.

June 30, 2026 – 2142 hours

Officers were dispatched to an unruly juvenile complaint on N. Main Street.

July 1, 2026 – 1337 hours

Officers were dispatched to a business on State Route 725 for a theft complaint. Officers were able to locate the suspect vehicle and initiated a traffic stop on Ambridge Drive. After identifying the suspect, it was also discovered that they had an active warrant out of Kettering. The subject was cited for the theft charge and released to the custody of Kettering PD.
